

# Wight Woodturners - Club Insurance

---

The Club has Craft Insurance cover, arranged through brokers Ian I Wallace Ltd and underwritten by Hiscox Ltd, which provides Public and Employers' Liability Insurance together with insurance for Club property. The current Insurance certificates are displayed.

## Liability Insurance

To ensure the Club, Members and Public are covered by this Liability Insurance there are a number of conditions of insurance that all members should be aware of and adhere to when undertaking Club activities. The principal points are:-

- The Club activities shall ONLY support the craft of Woodturning and the promotion of Woodturning and associated skills.
- The Liability Insurance covers members teaching craft skills to both adults and children.
- The Liability Insurance covers Club members and members of the non-participating public during woodturning demonstrations at craft fairs, shows and exhibitions.
- When teaching or demonstrating, the Club shall carry out a Risk Assessment, appropriate to the situation, to minimize or eliminate hazards to both members and the public.
- When attending craft fairs, shows or exhibitions NON-MEMBERS shall NOT be invited to participate, demonstrate or exhibit.
- Where turned items, which may be classified as TOYS, are made by club members these may not be sold or given-away unless the item complies with the requirements of BS EN 71 - Safety of Toys.
- There shall be NO Club activities involving the application of naked flames or excessive heat within a building or an enclosed area.
- There shall be NO Club activities involving working chainsaws (unless it can be shown that ALL participating members hold a nationally recognized chainsaw training and assessment certificate).
- The Club must NOT sell or supply any second hand electrical goods.
- The Club must NOT sell or supply any item containing electrical components nor any item that contains a lotion, cream or suchlike which is applied to any part of the body or hair.
